Dear Dr. Smith:

I have read your advertisement in the latest issue of *Riker-Service*. The Department of Psychiatry of the New York Medical College has been actively involved in developing a Community Mental Health Center in New York City under the direction of the Chairman of the Department, Dr. Alfred M. Freedman. The development of the Community Mental Health Center is one of the principal activities of the Department, and encompasses such programs as partial hospitalization, brief hospitalization with visiting nurse aftercare, a narcotic addiction treatment evaluation center, walk-in clinics as well as the more conventional treatment units. A new 13-story facility is under construction and is scheduled for completion in July 1969.

The Department has 44 resident physicians in training this year and has a variety of specialized basic research divisions which complement the clinical programs.

Recruitment has recently increased to provide for the staffing of this new facility, and if participation in this program is of interest to you, I would be pleased to review your curriculum vitae.
