I have spoken to Bill Turner regarding the Dilantin study and the Dreyfus Fund. They are particularly interested in the effect of Dilantin in out-patients, neurotics and psychopathic states. When I described the adolescent population available to you, Bill Turner thought this was very interesting. The Dilantin meeting will be part of the ACNP and will take place at 3:00 pm on December 7. It is an open meeting, and I believe we should plan to go. I asked Bill Turner to arrange a meeting with the appropriate people after the presentations, if they were interested in supporting the study which I had described. I have been over the ECDEU reports and the dissociation paper, but will need more time with both, probably sending them to you by Monday.
