Enclosed are three copies of the first draft of our progress report No. 3 describing the EEG changes with fenfluramine, amobarbital, dextroamphetamine and placebo. We are enclosing some of the tables to give you an idea of the material with which we worked.

In addition to the fenfluramine material, I am pleased to enclose copies of two depression rating scales which you requested - the Hamilton Scale and our own depression rating scale modified from Lehmann-Rockliff. I have been told that the Hamilton Scale is the one that the ECDE groups of NIMH will probably use. However, we have found it convenient to use our own scale for the time being, but will probably go to the Hamilton Scale in our next study.
