I had the pleasure of lunching on Friday with Dr. J. Remarque, of Elsevier, and discussed with him the possible publication of the technical manual enclosed herewith. He indicated that you were planning to bring up-to-date the methods of computer analysis of EEG as described in your EEG supplement.
