Enclosed is a suggested text for a summary of the volume.  
I hope that it may be satisfactory.

In addition I have prepared a set of forms which include the names cited in the various articles of the more unusual compounds. Compounds such as morphine, atropine and scopolamine are not cited. All those which are used in the text, their chemical formula, trade names and manufacturer are provided on the pages. There are three cited items which I have been unable to find in the available literature. Perhaps these are available to you. They are bensazine, BA 1433 (WH 4849), and naphtyzin.

Since I am not sure of the form that should be used, I have asked my secretary to prepare these on individual sheets and if the publisher will provide a form, it should be a simple matter to prepare the citation list.
