It has been a good many years since we chatted at Bellevue but I have had occasion to follow your work.

I am writing today with regard to Dr. Adam Rosenblatt who has given your name as a reference. He is applying for a third year resident position at the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry and I would appreciate your opinion regarding his personality and his recent growth in the training program. Dr. Rosenblatt has expressed an interest in completing his residency here and then going on to a research career, and I would be grateful for your estimate regarding his abilities in the research area.

As you may know, I left New York last September and have devoted the past year to establishing a research center. It is coming along very well and I now have seven scientists on the professional staff and laboratories in pharmacology, psychology, neurophysiology, and a computer center.
