Dear Harry,

It was good to chat with you again in Baltimore. I found the sessions very interesting, particularly the reports of the antidepressant effects of endorphin.

I enclose two reprints-- one, our assessment of DH-524 suggesting that its EEG profile was more similar to that of cannabis derivatives and therefore of psychopharmacologic interest; and a recent summary of the EEG profile methods, indicating that the methodology seems to have a place in phase-1 evaluation of new putative psychotherapeutic moieties.

Let me know if you come across a viable 'alpha EEG enhancer' -- it should be useful in the clinic (and the marketplace).
