Dear Dr. Bryant:

When the transfer of Operations funds of the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry are made to the University of Missouri, the actual sum will approximate \$5,700 which indicates the unexpended balance as of December 31, 1964. Under the Division policies, the third and fourth allotments would be due as follows:

January 1, 1965	\$ 7,000.00
April 1, 1965	\$ 4,900.00

But, perhaps, under the circumstances the total of \$17,600 will be transferred January 1, 1965.

Already encumbered in this figure is a contract between the Division of Mental Diseases on behalf of the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry with Washington University for the operations of our computer center. This contract states that the Washington University Computer Center will provide the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry with such computer equipment as they deem necessary for our operation, supplies as may from time to time be required, supervision of the center, and such consultations as may from time to time be requested by the scientists of the Institute. The Washington University Computer Center has made access to their large scale computer available as we have needed it without additional cost to the Institute. The charges for these services are paid from available funds in the following fashion:

The maintenance of the equipment, supplies, general consultation fees are paid monthly, on statements rendered by the Washington University Computer Center. During the past six months the charges have been between \$2,300 and \$2,500 per month.

In addition, because the early development in the computer center has been in EEG analysis, additional charges of \$600 per month have been made from MH-07249. Funds are now available for the continuation of this payment to April 30, 1965.
