Dear Dean:

I had some difficulty in obtaining the age on each of the subjects because the original cards had been misplaced. These are now available, and I am enclosing the write-out for each subject.

The mean age of the first twenty subjects is 23, and the mean age of the last twenty is 43.

To continue in this vein, I am calling Max in New York and asking that he obtain samples of the original records of these subjects and send them to me for a review by Dr. Itil. I hope, in this way, to get a better picture of why this difference appears in the analyzer record. It is a very interesting finding and we should track it down. When I come, I will bring a deck of the social data so that you can add this information to the Hillside Hospital tape.
