Dear Lyle:

Hank shared with me your letter of January 22, and I am pleased to send you a copy of the summary of our experiences with high doses of OI-63, as you requested in your letter.

The only unusual CNS effect was the transient development of bursts of 3-5 cps, 80-150 μ v appearing for 5-30 seconds somewhere about 50 minutes after the administration. These bursts were short and self-limited and did not appear again for the remainder of the observation period. This observation was made in three subjects--in one it was very clear and in two it was found only on careful review of the records.
