Dear Turan,

We have modified the laboratory data form to suit some of the needs of this laboratory. We are awaiting a new proof but I am enclosing a xerox copy of the latest draft available to me.

This will indicate some of the changes which we have considered advisable after using the MIP form for the past few months. These include color divisions between items; exact values above the place to be marked; the addition of items for standards, laboratory and route, which we believe will be useful.

We are working on a second form for medical examination believing that a single sheet on a single side is the best for our purpose. The laboratory form will be completed by a laboratory technician. We are working on another form to be completed by a physician and/or technical research person and this will include such items as weight, blood pressure and skin and eye changes.

As soon as a provisional copy is available I will send it to you.
