Dear Jonathan:

This is to confirm our appointment for Thursday afternoon, November 18, at 3:00 p.m. I will be flying in from St. Louis and may arrive a few minutes late if the planes are delayed.

I have met with George and Mr. Warren Thompson, the Assistant Chairman of the Department, and have tried to estimate the programmatic needs of MH-11380 (EEG and Human Psychopharmacology) for the remainder of this year's program. I have asked the University to concur in some recommendations which I may be able to discuss with you regarding an orderly transition and the possible transfer of some funds from this grant for continued data analysis and write-up.

Dr. Denber has been sending us the tapes on a regular basis and this analysis is progressing very well. However, it is probably to our best interests to begin some of the analyses during the next few months. To do so, will require that you make available to me the code for the patients in his program. With his concurrence, I am asking that you or Dr. Prien make available to us the drug treatment designations by patient name for the Manhattan State population in the schizophrenia project. We will not discuss these with him but it will permit us to analyze the data on the pretreatment electroencephalograms and to determine if the groups are evenly matched according to these criteria.
