SUBJECT Summer Fellowships for Medical Students

Attached is an application of a first year medical student at Missouri University, Mr. John Samet, who is applying for a summer fellowship.

We have had one Missouri University and one St. Louis University fellow~~s~~ in 1963, and one Washington University and one St. Louis University fellow in 1964, each paid by University grants and not our own funds. Would it be appropriate for you to ask Dean Bryant or Dean Wilson whether they would consider allocating one or more grants to this Department for the summer fellowship program? (These grants are apparently provided by SKS or NIH or the University's own resources)

If the University would consider such allocation, would you please recommend the proper procedure which we might follow for such an appointment? Insofar as Mr. Samet's home is in St. Louis, he has written to us so that he could be near his home during the summer.
