Our programs in computer analysis of EEG are quite active now, and I am pleased to enclose summaries of our project reports dated October, 1963, and the addendum of January, 1964. In addition, the abstract dated February 20, for the Central EEG Society, and copies of the two abstracts just submitted to the American EEG society are enclosed.

I have not yet written a full paper on this subject, as we have been developing our program, and only in the last three to four months have we been collecting data systematically. I have found the work quite fascinating and believe that the equipment, and the arts of the programmers give me a great deal of flexibility in the studies of EEG pattern changes with drugs. I hope the promise is fulfilled during the next year.
