Dear Professor Miras:

Since your letter of January 10, I have had the opportunity to speak to a number of people in Washington and New York regarding a study program in marijuana. It is our intention to apply to the Public Health Service for support. There are aspects of these studies that may best be done in association with your laboratories.

For this reason, I would like to visit with you in April or May. At present it is possible that I will be in Yugoslavia at the end of April (24-26) and could visit with you immediately thereafter. If I am not successful in making this trip, I will definitely be in Europe in mid-May and would plan to visit with you about May 20. Are either of these periods agreeable? I will write to you as soon as my plans are crystallized.

We are very much interested in obtaining some additional THC and was pleased to read that you now have 2 grams. Would it be possible to reserve at least one gram for our use?
