I have just received the ACNP bulletin describing the focus for the December Puerto Rican Meeting as drug abuse. This is an area of recent interest for me, stimulated by studies of the narcotic antagonist, cyclazocine. I began these in St. Louis and am continuing them in New York. If time is available, I would be pleased to present a description of the EEG patterns of this compound, and discuss the relation of these data to the extensive EEG reports of narcotics by many others.
