The report of our studies with cycloserine is finally being typed and a copy will be sent to you shortly. In the meanwhile, reviewing the EEG and clinical data, we became particularly interested in the question of whether cycloserine has been studied for its effects in alcoholics. Do you have any information available as to whether it has been administered either acutely or chronically in the treatment of alcoholism?

In the treatment of tuberculosis, have there been any reports that the administration of cycloserine has altered the intake of alcohol?
