The Missouri Institute of Psychiatry, now a Division of the University of Missouri School of Medicine, has recently established a set of pharmacology and neurophysiology laboratories in support of the principle programs of research in psychopharmacology. We are interested now in developing a laboratory in clinical chemistry, both as a supporting unit to the clinical psychopharmacology programs, and for basic research.

This Institution was established in September, 1962 and effective January 1, 1965 becomes a Department of the School of Medicine of the University of Missouri. I am enclosing a copy of our first annual report which provides the best summary of the structure of the Institution.
