I am very grateful for a copy of the symposium report on histamine receptor antagonists. While there is little evidence in the volume on effects on the brain, I believe this type of work will have special interest for us. I cannot believe that Nature would not try to use the same tools in all parts of the body.

In addition to our continued interest in EEG, I have replaced my enthusiasm for narcotic antagonists (which occupied so much of my time these past seven years) with an interest in the natural occurring peptides with central effects. For your interest, I am enclosing two reports, one on EEG and one on peptides, which may be of interest.
