Dear Norman,

Separately I am sending you three copies of the summary report and the statistical data of the EEG studies of oral thiothixene.

As you know, we undertook a pilot phase and a preliminary profile study. These data became the basis for the study presented here.

The EEG profile of a single 10 mg dose of thiothixene is clearly defined, distinct from placebo, and identical for both the capsule and concentrate formulations. The profile of thiothixene is consistent with the antipsychotic class of drugs in our published classifications. (*Ann. Rev. Pharmacol.*, 9: 241-258, 1969).

I want to thank you for the opportunity to undertake this study and I regret that it took much longer than I anticipated. However, we did learn very much and I am pleased with the outcome.
