I have been reviewing some of the notes from the 1961 symposium on EEG and Human Psychopharmacology in Montreal. At that time, you indicated that you had experience with a group of "frozen" schizophrenic patients in whom you had undertaken pneumoencephalography. With the cooperation of Dr. Turan Itil, who joined my staff at this new institute last year, we have decided to undertake a study similar to your own in the patient populations of St. Louis State Hospital.
