Dear Mr. Potter:

My associates and I would like to go ahead with the exchange of an FR-1300 for a 7 channel SP-300 with four additional record/reproduce amplifiers. The translation of our present family of tapes, approximately 100, from FR-1300 compatible to SP-300 compatible is required, and as soon as the details of the exchange are completed, we will work out a transfer of these tapes to your laboratories for such translation.

A necessary step in this exchange is a signed requisition from the University of Missouri, which now is technically the owner of the FR-1300. Attached is a purchase order copy which has just been submitted to the University for their acceptance. The University will bear no responsibility for the additional charges listed in your letter of July 2, 1965. These additional charges (\$3,825) will be paid by the Psychiatric Research Foundation of Missouri. This contract relationship of the Foundation is contingent upon the University's allowing the exchange.

As soon as the University has signed the requisition, I shall contact you again.
