Dear Prof. Salemink,

It was kind of you to visit my laboratory and share your experiences with cannabis with us. I regret that your visit was so short, and trust that we will have a more extended opportunity in the near future. I have been informed that there may be a conference on cannabis in New York later this year, and I have taken the liberty of suggesting your name as one of the participants.

During your visit, you mentioned the possibility of supplying marijuana and hashish of known strength for our studies. I would be pleased to take advantage of your offer, and in exchange, send you copies of our findings as soon as they are available. We have a limited supply of marijuana and the hashish is of average quality. We would like to undertake systematic studies in about 30 subjects, 2 trials each, using the equivalent of 1 Gm. marijuana each experiment, for a total of 60 grams (marijuana) or equivalent in hashish.

I would be grateful for your advice as to what may be available and how it is to be shipped.
