Dear Dr. Kark:

In reply to your recent letter of October 26th regarding the status of Dr. A. M. Don, I am pleased to state that the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry at the St. Louis State Hospital is accredited by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology for a full training program in psychiatry. The Institute has at the present time nineteen residents in training in each of the three years.

In addition, participation in the programs of this institution have been accredited by the boards as clinical experience credit.

In his appointment as a Senior Research Scientist (Psychiatry), Dr. Don is responsible for the care of a block of patients within the Institute and for the supervision of all of the studies in those patients. At the present time, he is actively involved with a group of psychotic patients in whom he is assessing a variety of new and established therapy measures. In this role, he supervises research nurses, ward nurses and aides and attendants. In addition, he is a consultant to the University of Missouri School of Nursing affiliated nursing program and in this role teaches 2nd and 3rd year nursing students. He also is an active participant in the residency training programs where he is a supervisor to a number of resident trainees. In this role he supervises their clinical activities.
