In response to your request, enclosed is a summary of a special meeting, convened on June 4, 1970, to review the available data on the use of Narcotic Antagonists in Opiate Dependence.

The work of this Department is under the personal direction of the Chairman, Alfred M. Freedman. He is Professor of Psychiatry and has been chairman since 1960. He has supervised a narcotic addiction treatment and research program in the Department since 1961.

I joined the program in 1966, and am Professor of Psychiatry, and Director of the Division of Biological Psychiatry.

We have accommodated requests such as yours, making available the resources of our center as the project may require. In each instance, particularly with profit-making concerns, or agencies operating under reimbursement contracts, our fees are negotiated in advance. I would be pleased to discuss your program with you before August 1, or you may wish to negotiate with the chairman after September 1.
