Dear Jonathan:

This letter is to confirm our telephone conversation of December 11.

I have made travel arrangements for a site visit to Gainesville on Sunday, January 17, 1965. I hold reservations on flight National 219 leaving the National Airport in Washington at 6 PM, arriving in Jacksonville at 8:05. To be in Puerto Rico by Monday morning, I have scheduled the flight leaving Jacksonville at 12:00 (Eastern ^{United 747}) which brings me to Miami in time for Eastern 105, arriving in San Juan at 8:25. This visit would require that the staff at Gainesville be available early Sunday morning and that we complete the visit in time for me to be back in Jacksonville by 1:45 at the latest. Will you write to them or should I, to confirm their being available that morning? I am presuming that I will stay overnight in Gainesville, driving from Jacksonville.

I would also appreciate the opportunity for you to meet with Turan and myself on Thursday afternoon, January 14th, to discuss MH-07249 supplementary study of the collaborative schizophrenia program, as well as our data regarding a unique program of research in a largely untreated population of mentally ill in Istanbul. We plan to arrive in Baltimore at 1:35 and should be at the International Inn by 3 PM. Would you be able to set that time aside for us?
