Enclosed is a memorandum prepared by my associate, Dr. Rhea Dornbush, which describes the procedures for memory testing we found useful in our ECT and cannabis studies. This paradigm may be applicable to the study of OI-63 and seizures. If the task is too simple or too difficult for your population, the range of tasks allows a ready modification, by increasing complexity or simplification, to accommodate your immediate needs.

The articles on OI-63 appear in volume 32, Progress in Brain Research, edited by de Wied and Weijnen and carries the title "Pituitary, Adrenals and the Brain".

It was good to talk to you at length, and hope we can find the occasion soon to discuss OI-63 and GB-94 further.
