Dear Jonathan:

The data collection phase of the EEG material of the collaborative schizophrenia project is now complete. My Denber has collected records during the pre-drug period and at one, two, four and six month periods. We have analyzed all the tapes we have received except for eight, and these will be completed within the next few days.

As an initial step, we compared the three treatment groups in the pre-drug condition, to see if the records had any significant differences in EEG criteria. I am pleased to tell you that the sampling was quite good for these criteria.

We have made some recommendations regarding the analyses of the EEG data alone, to answer such questions as the differences in EEG patterns at each of the time periods.

These analyses are only one part of the study which you projected. It would be important to discuss the behavioral EEG correlations if these are of interest to your study group. When I discussed this with Hy earlier this week, he agreed to call your office, and perhaps to arrange for some discussion during the CINP meetings. If this can be arranged, or, if you would like to have Dr. Bonato visit us, either step would be helpful.

I look forward to seeing you at the CINP.
