Dear Dr. Reggini:

Dr. George Ulett referred your letter of August 18th to me for reply. Your interest in Artificial Intelligence is a commendable one. The research programs on the application of Computers to Psychiatry at this Institution are devoted largely to problems of the classification of patients using taxonomic methods, changes in Electroencephalograms induced by psychotropic drugs, and many statistical applications which are documented, in detail, in the field of Psychiatry. We do not have a program with relation to Artificial Intelligence, nor do I know of a publicly acknowledged program in this subject in St. Louis. The other major computer groups, in the city, have problems more similar to those of this Institute than the problem of Artificial Intelligence.

I regret that I can not be of further help, but would look forward to having you visit us when you are in St. Louis.
