Dear Bill,

We have received the AHR-1118 data and find that single doses of 200 mg seem adequate to produce an EEG change. To verify this, however, I would like to run a few single trials at higher dosages, specifically 250, 300 and 400 mg. I would like to run two to four experiments at each dose.

Our data to date show 200 mg (~~10~~ 3.4 mg/kg) are safe and well tolerated by volunteers.
