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Dear Bob,

The first analyses of the EEG changes at twelve minute intervals, using 17 variables demonstrates significant differences among the compounds at various times. We are now ready to plot these variables and to select those that appear to be the most discriminative.

I am heartened by this finding, because it means that we probably have significant discrimination somewhere in the data, although at this point I cannot tell you which from which. The plotting should be done within the week and the necessary analyses will be undertaken on November 11, when I go to St. Louis.
