Dear Dr. Black:

Enclosed are corrected pages for the manuscript "Drugs, EEG and Behavior" following your suggestions yesterday.

You may use the quotation from Lewin for the whole volume, although if reprints are to be made available to the authors, I would be grateful if the publisher would, as partial compensation for such use, set up my reprints with this paragraph as a frontispiece.

Table II should be corrected so that the heading for:

Ia Mainly increased slowing
Ib With Increased Alpha
Ic With Increased Seizure Activity
IIa With Increased Amplitude
IIb With Decreased Amplitude

The drugs in each column should be listed alphabetically, but the parentheses should be maintained wherever indicated.

Also, in Table II the type selected for the title of class IV and V, alpha increase, alpha decrease, should be the same as the typeface for class I, II and III. Page 7, paragraphs 3 and 4 marked in italic are to be replaced by the paragraphs appended.

On page 8, a footnote should be added with the asterisk after the word "phantastica". The footnote is appended.

The title on page 8, "Clinical - EEG Applications" should be deleted.

On page 9, the two paragraphs relating to the delirians should be replaced by the paragraphs appended.
