This morning I received the copies of the application for research grant submitted on September 23, 1964 as a supplement to MH-07249-03. The DRG has edited the application to change the dates to the period October 1, 1966 to September 3, 1967 and marked the application as MH-07249-05. The form indicates that this is prepared for the March, 1965 council and is sent to SRC.

As I had discussed with you, this application is a supplement to permit the computer explorations to continue for an additional eighteen month period, at the same time as the last eighteen month period of the basic grant. It is my hope that this program will indeed show sufficient results to warrant reapplication for continued support. However, I do not feel that these forms are for that purpose.
