Enclosed is the additional information you requested. The research nurse, Miss O'Farrell, has represented the changes in trifluoperidol dosage in a graphic form. By comparing the dates on top with the summaries which you now hold, it should be simple to determine the amounts of trifluoperidol each patient received. The records also indicate the subsequent medication for each of the patients and while this is not germane to your immediate interest, it is important for us and I have decided not to delete this in your copies.

Dr. Itil has permitted me to send you copies of the reports on EEG's for those patients who have been assessed in a classical fashion.
