I am pleased to accept your invitation to present some of our data on the EEG profile of doxepin. For purposes of reference, the following are pertinent.

I am Professor of Psychiatry, New York Medical College; and the Director of the Division of Biological Psychiatry of the Department of Psychiatry. I have been at this college since 1966.
