Dear Dr. van Gogh:

I am writing on behalf of Dr. Turan Itil in whose favor the Foundation has entered an order for a two-channel telemetry system. This order was dated January 6, 1965, and as you know, at your request, we have issued a letter of credit in the amount of \$1,944.00 on March 3, 1965, for a six month period. This letter of credit is now beyond the due date of September 3, 1965.

As we discussed with you in Salzburg, the Foundation regrets that this contract has not as yet been fulfilled. We are requesting, therefore, cancellation of this contract, and would like to have the letter of credit returned to be deposited to our account.

If, in the next few months, your laboratories are able to provide the two-channel telemetry system, the Foundation is prepared to renew the order upon the demonstration that the system meets ~~is~~ exceeds the specifications set forth in our original purchase order dated January 13, 1965.

Incidentally, the film presented by Dr. Storm van Leeuwen was excellent, and I do hope that your system will provide for two channels what he has so capably accomplished.
