Dear Mr. Yeager:

Thank you very much for your description of the HYDAC 2000. The application of this equipment to our problems is not at all clear to me. Do you know of an installation of this kind in the St. Louis area in an unclassified facility?

Our present operation is the analysis of EEG signals. The analog signal is digitized and then using the IBM 1710, or a 7072, we are carrying out programs of auto-correlation, cross-correlation, base line cross - period analysis, and power spectral analysis. Some of these functions can be done in analog form.

In the event that one of your representatives is in the St. Louis area, I should appreciate an opportunity to have him visit with me.
