So far, the experimental peptides are in trials in patients following induced seizures (convulsive therapy) and in elderly patients with 'normal' forgetting. Should these continue to be successful, I have every expectation that the experiments will be broadened to other population samples. For the meanwhile, the rules of drug research prohibit trials in individual patients with disorders outside those for which trials have been approved.
