Dear Norman,

Some time ago, Gardos and Cole asked us to assist them in the analysis of their data of a chronic high and low dose thiothixene study. They supplied the tapes, we did the analyses. There were some problems in the data collection, related chiefly to the cooperation of the patients and our inability to train the staff adequately. Nevertheless, the analyses do demonstrate consistent EEG effects, similar for the high dose thiothixene as we found some time ago.
