Dear Harold,

Dr. Bradley and I are pleased to confirm the invitation for your participation in the Symposium on Anticholinergic Hallucinogens at the forthcoming meeting of the CINP, to be held in Washington, D.C. on March 29 and 31. We look forward to the presentation entitled "An Examination of a Possible Cholinergic Link in the EEG Arousal Reaction," by Dr. Z. Cuculic and yourself. As there are still a few questions about the ability of some of the European invitees to attend the meeting, it will be a few weeks before we can send a definitive program *and time schedule.*

Five reports will be presented during each three hour session, allowing thirty-five minutes for each presentation and discussion. Since the discussion may be of special interest to the participants, the report should be about 20 minutes in length.

The CINP has permitted us to consider the publication of this symposium separately. Insofar as this subject is becoming increasingly important, we believe that the association of the work of the participants in a single volume will be a valuable contribution, and ask your cooperation in making a manuscript available at the time of the meeting. The manuscript should be approximately 20 pages of text, plus bibliography and illustrations.

With regard to the date of your presentation, I have just received Bulletin III of the CINP which indicates that our section will take place Tuesday morning and all day Thursday. Rather than ask the Program Chairmen to alter the program, we will schedule your presentation for Tuesday morning. This should make it possible for you to make arrangements for the side trip you have in mind. We would be very pleased, however, if you could attend
