Dear Jonathan,

I am writing with regard to MH-11380, "EEG and Human Psychopharmacology." As you know, this program will complete its fourth year of study at St. Louis this September. I have reviewed the status of all the projects in this program with both Drs. Itil and Shapiro, my coworkers, to the extent that it will be practicable, many of the data collection portions of this program will be completed by early summer. However, the data analyses will not be completed and to provide funds for this part of the program, I have formulated an application for funds to complete this program, but at the New York Medical College. Enclosed are copies of the first few pages of the application which I have sent to Al Freedman for his approval and the signatures of the Dean. I have asked that the application be sent directly to you and request its consideration at the June/July meetings of the appropriate committees.

The monographic manual describing the technical experiences with digital computer analysis of EEG is now almost complete, requiring only collation and the preparation of a suitable cover. I will submit a copy within the next few weeks, and if additional copies may be helpful to the committees consideration, I will be glad to send it, as well as copies of any other of our publications, for your consideration.
