Dear Dr. Burhan:

Thank you for your letter of May 14, 1963 and your kind offer to participate in the preparation of the bibliography "EEG and Human Psychopharmacology". I have had the opportunity to go over the references that you sent and I found a number which our files did not have. This will be fine except that some of the references, which are not in our file, are primarily animal studies, and as such, are to be excluded.

I have also checked with the editor of the EEG Journal and he is unable to give me an answer as to whether to include a KWIC index as well as the subject index.

Also, the style of our bibliography is such that the original language title is to be included, followed in parenthesis by our translation into English. As I read your sample reference list, I find some titles in English without the original available to me.

I would appreciate the following:

I would be grateful if you could run off a few sample pages using EEG titles in KWIC index form, so that I may show these to the editor.

Is there some way of checking each of the references as to their content (man), without going back to the original articles?

Is there some way of retrieving the original titles of foreign articles from your records without going back to the original article?

I look forward to working with you. Thank you for your cooperation.
