Dear Bob:

My associates and I have read the careful comments made by Mike Free and his co-workers. As we planned, we would like to take the next step in this study, controlling those variables which we believe were problems in the first study. Are there any additional suggestions for this phase of our program?

To continue the study we envisage, will require additional supplies. Since I only have six sets of the drug available, perhaps you would like to send the same material but coded differently, If you wish to do so, that would be agreeable to us.

In doing this study, however, we would like to add an additional condition. We are anxious to determine the differences between barbiturates and central stimulants. For this reason, would you consider supplying us with 30 sets of 10 mg of dextroamphetamine, labeled "SKF-5."

If this is feasible, I would also like you to send me 200 blank capsules so that I could make up a sixth sample containing an experimental stimulant which is of interest to us.

Would you call me early next week to discuss these questions?
