Dear Al,

The studies of fluphenazine at high dosage, undertaken in St. Louis and in Istanbul, were completed in 1971. The studies resulted in a number of internal memoranda describing the effects and some EEG and behavioral reports published by Professor T. Itil of the University of Missouri.

The studies were suspended when they were completed; the initial supplies of fluphenazine were either completely used in the study, or used at lower dosage in the clinical care of patients. No stocks of high dosage fluphenazine exist.

By this letter, I am notifying Professor Itil that the IND 5210 is hereby suspended; and shall ask him to forward to your office, copies of the reports of the studies for your information.
