Dear Oldrich,

I have just received your letter of April 5, 8 and 9, as well as the grouping of free communications in alphabetic order. - (2) For the co-chairman on cannabis, would you consider Dr. Alfred M. Freedman of our College instead of Dr. Keup? Dr. Freedman is planning to attend the Congress, and is the co-director of a national Center for Studies of Substance Abuse.

You are doing a fine job. Keep it up - and we will have a celebration in Prague!
