Dear Miss Welsh:

I am most pleased with the kind letters we have received from Drs. Aungle and Scott. I should be pleased to recommend your appointment to this Institute as an EEG Technician, at an initial salary of \$320.00 per month, effective March 1, 1964. This appointment is subject to the rules of the Division of Mental Diseases of the State of Missouri, which provide for a six-month probationary period.

It is possible for us to advance your fare to Missouri. This can be done, subject to an agreement that if your work is satisfactory to the director of the laboratory, that you will continue to work for a period of one year. In the event that you leave voluntarily for personal reasons, that you are willing to repay the travel allowance in full if such departure is within the first six months, and prorated during the subsequent six-month period.

If this is satisfactory, I would appreciate your completing the application form enclosed in your own handwriting and returning it with a recent snapshot of yourself.
