The qualifications listed in the APA Mail Pouch are of interest to me. This research center, first established in October, 1962, is now in the second stage of its development, and we are now considering applications for appointment to the staff in our training program, and in clinical psychiatric research. I am taking the liberty of enclosing a description of the Institute as written a year and a half ago.

Laboratories in clinical neurophysiology, pharmacology, clinical chemistry, clinical psychology, and the computer center are all operational at the present time. Five of the wards of the Institute are now open, and it is our plan to have the sixth operational by the spring of the year. We have received extensive support from the community, from the State of Missouri, and from the National Institute of Mental Health.
