Dear Dr. Frazier:

My associates and I would like to prepare a demonstration for the forthcoming Detroit meeting of the American Psychiatric Association entitled, "Application of Digital Computer Analyses of the EEG to Psychiatry." For this demonstration, we would like to emphasize the procedures developed during the past few years for the classification of EEG signals and some of the applications to psychopharmacology and clinical psychiatry. The core of the demonstration will be tape recordings of EEG signals analyzed in real time, utilizing an IBM 1800 system.

For this purpose, floor space of approximately 12' x 40' would be required.
