Dear Dr. Gonik:

Dr. Donald Sundland has referred your curriculum vitae to me for review. I am pleased that you may be interested in a position at this institute, and I do hope that he has been able to give you a picture of the programs here. I have reviewed your record with interest, and would like to process this further. From the publications listed, it is apparent that your interests are similar to those of some members of the staff.

At the present time, the position that is available is one in relating behavioral change variables to electrographic variables during changes induced by drugs under both acute and chronic conditions. While most of the work is with psychiatric subjects, we are now establishing an animal laboratory and hope to undertake some parallel studies in dogs. I hope that Dr. Sundland was able to show you something of the equipment and the facilities.

I should like for you to have an opportunity to visit our laboratories again and for me to have a chance to meet with you. Prior to that, however, I should like permission to write to two or three references. Also, it would be quite helpful for me to have a chance to see copies of your theses and the two reports that are unpublished on EEG recording and analysis methods. I have asked the librarian to obtain copies of your other publications and I will have a chance to read these shortly.

If this is agreeable to you, I should like to write to your references as soon as you indicate them, and then arrange for you to visit our laboratories as soon thereafter as practicable.
