Dear Turan,

Don reminded me that we have not sent you samples of the laboratory data output. I was waiting for xerox copies of the full set, but these will not be available for a few more days. In the meantime, enclosed are sample sets from one of our analyses.

The laboratory standards are our standards and your reports will, of course, have a similar set with your standards listed. Where it states New York Medical College, we will list MIP.

Each individual sheet is a single report from a single optical scan sheet. The age, sex, date, drug and dosage were keypunched separately from lists supplied by my staff. In the new forms this data will come directly from the form. The third type of output is a listing of all the tests for each patient and this is derived directly from the individual sheets (you will note that these do not have drug or dosage listed for each date and this will be corrected in the new forms).

We are able to handle the MIP-PLD forms and provide you with these outputs. To do so would require the forms and a clear statement on the head of each form of the main, drug, dosage, age and sex of the subjects.

We can provide outputs for your present forms now and should be able for the new forms within two months.
